Selection

Mousserende - Sparkling - Vins Moussoux - Champagnes

Cava Vibracions Brut Reserva, Joseph Masachs, Penedès, Spain

This sparkling wine has a light golden yellow colour. The long maturation on the 24-month bottle creates a very subtle and fine mouse with persistent bubbles. A beautiful subdued scent of citrus fruit and apple with hints of flowers. In the mouth, this Cava is fresh, elegant and good in structure. The aftertaste is long fresh, persistent and soft. Delicious as aperitif! **GLASS 6.5 | BOTTLE 32**

Prosecco Spumante, Pronol, Veneto, Italy

This prosecco, made from the Glera grape has a very light aroma but comes back stronger in its flavour. Starting with a soft dry core, surrounded by delicate but present notes of stone fruit such as peach and apricot. Sparkling and pleasantly fresh. Works particularly well as an aperitif but pairs well with our shellfish dishes and vegetarian dishes in our vegetarian menu. **GLASS 8 | BOTTLE 40**

Azienda Agricola Pratello, PINK Garda Rosé Brut, Lombardy, Italy

Bright salmon pink colour, aromas of apricots, cherries, raspberry and roses comes through. The flavour is powerful but balanced. An elegant wine with beautiful freshness and mousse. Nice long aftertaste. Delicious with fatter fish (such as salmon and mackerel), shellfish and crustaceans. **BOTTLE 49**

Waris-Lamandier, Cuvéé "Racines de Trois" Brut Champagne

Cuvée Racines de Trois represents the "three roots" of Waris-Larmandier: the contribution of the three siblings to the project, and their use of three grape varieties (chardonnay, pinot noir, and meunier). Racines de Trois is a certified organic and biodynamic Champagne. The Waris-Larmandier style is terroir-focused, understated, structured, and ultra-elegant. It has an intense straw yellow colour, a fine foam and aromas of citrus, berries, ripe pears and stone fruits, enhanced with limestone and chalk. This champagne is velvety and silky in the mouth, with a fine dosage and crunchy acidity, ideal as an aperitif. **BOTTLE 99**

Moët & Chandon "EMPERIAL" Brut Champagne

The composition reflects the diversity and complementarity of the three grape varieties: pinot noir, meunier and chardonnay. This champagne has an elegant gold straw yellow colour with green accents. Aromas of green apple and citrus fruit with fresh and mineral nuances. The flavour is a combination of juicy white fruit (pear, peach, apple), and of citrus fruit and gooseberries with fine bubbles. Perfect with sushi and sashimi. **GLASS 21 | BOTTLE 105**

Wit - White - Vin Blanc

Chardonnay-Viognier, De Grendel, West-Cape, South-Africa | 2022

Straw yellow in colour. Aroma of stone fruit, apple and kiwi. Flavour of apricot, peach and pear from the Viognier and the creamy citrus from the Chardonnay. Delicious all round wine that pairs well with all of our dishes. **GLASS 6 | BOTTLE 30**

Gewürztraminer, Gerd Stepp, Pfalz, Germany | 2022

Gewürztraminer is known to be fresh and floral. Notes of rose petals, apple blossoms and jasmine aromas, with bright citrus, quince and pear on the palate. **GLASS 7 | BOTTLE 35**



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Wit - White - Vin Blanc

Kono Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New-Zealand | 2022

A fresh white wine 100% made from the Sauvignon Blanc grape. This Sauvignon Blanc has beautiful aromas of citrus combined with gooseberries and guava. In the mouth a taste of tropical ripe fruits. Lush and ripe fruits go well with fresh citrus notes and a nice acidity, with a long fresh aftertaste. **GLASS 7.5 | BOTTLE 37.5**

Grüner Veltliner "Terrassen", Jurtschitsch, Kamptal, Austria | 2022

Yellow with green undertones, this wine has fresh apple aromas with citrus notes and a pleasant peppery spiciness. The grapes are hand-picked and plucked and pressed with light pressure. The juice flows without the use of pumps from the four-story room in the basement where the fermentation takes place in chilled stainless steel tanks to convey the delicate aromas and flavours. **GLASS 7.5 | BOTTLE 37.5**

Pinot Grigio, I Castelli Romeo & Giulietta, Veneto, Italy | 2022

This smooth, fresh and fruity wine from I Castelli Romeo & Giulietta winery comes from Veneto in eastern Italy. The pinot Grigio grape gives this wine an aromatic character, with notes of passion fruit, pear and flowers. This makes it highly recommended as an aperitif, and with white fish. **GLASS 8 | BOTTLE 40**

Txakoli 'Garena', Iturrialde S.L., Basque, Spain | 2022

Garena is a crackling wine from Basque and is made from two local grape varieties: 80% hondarrabi zerratia, 20% hondarrabi zuri. Both grapes are separately fermented in the winery; part of the wine matures on the lie. This way one achieves a fresh and aromatic wine with a good structure and complexity. Wonderfully fresh taste of apple, flowers, grapefruit and is slightly sparkling. The first impression of the wine is especially fresh, then more complex notes and a full flavour. A surprising white wine that especially pairs well with meat dishes. **BOTTLE 42**

Silvaner VDP Retzstadt Ortswein, Weingut Rudolf May, Franken, Germany | 2021

This Frankish wine is made from healthy, ripe Silvaner grapes of the younger vines. This results in a very juicy, freshly tingling and fruity wine with fine acidity and an exotic aromas like pineapple. Excellent as an aperitif and grilled dishes. **BOTTLE 42**

Bergerac Blanc Sec, Cuvée Dianaïs, La Grande Maison, Bergerac, France | 2020

Beautiful blend of Sémillon, Sauvignon gris, and Muscadelle. Venerated on barriques, in the style of white burgundies. Ageing and fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Harmonious and very elegant wine, with a very fruity finish, a silky and delicate structure, a pleasant acidity. Its long and persistent finish mixes fruit flavours and mineral appearance. **BOTTLE 45**

Trebbiano Toscana 'Assentada', Az. Agr. Il Giardino di Sergio Falzari, Tuscany, Italy | 2020

Made of 100% Trebbiano Toscano grape. A layered wine with floral aromas and dried fruit with fresh notes. Matured in amphora (tall greek or roman jug) with skin-contact (grape peels in contact with the juice). Spicy and savoury in the aftertaste. This winery has a special place in our heart as we visited the winery in the summer of 2023 and fell in love with the philosophy and the passion they have of wine and wine-making **BOTTLE 48**

7 Grains, Domaine Barmès-Buecher, Elzas, France | 2022

Barmès-Buecher's 7 Grains is made from the press juice of seven different grapes: Pinot Gris, Gewurztraminer, Riesling, Pinot Blanc, Muscat, Pinot Noir and Chasselas. This juice is combined with the free-run juice from the entire harvest that has been collected at the sorting table and fermented together to create a very exciting Alsatian blend. There is a creamy texture on the palate that is kept fresh and lively by ample acidity which, combined with the mix of ripe fruits and stony minerality, yield a wine of great flavor and richness. Amazing paired with shellfish and crustaceans. **BOTTLE 52**



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Wit - White - Vin Blanc

Riesling GG 'Graacher Himmelreich' Alte Reben, Dr. Loosen, Mosel, Germany | 2021

This wine is both powerful and subtle, with notes of citrus, apple and nectarine, and a hint of mint. It has long, minerally aftertaste. A silky smooth texture due to the ageing of a full year on fine yeast residues. The winery Dr. Loosen is located between Bernkastel and Graach, in the middle of the Moselle and has been in the family for over 200 years. The vineyard area of this domain is of unparalleled quality, with the best positions on Grosse Lagen (Grand Cru vineyards) on the Mittelmosel. This riesling is made from vines that are over 100 years old. **BOTTLE 60**

Pouilly Fumé Tonnerre, Château Favray, Val de Loire, France | 2021

The name refers to Tonnerre limestone, the oldest and rarest terroir of the Pouilly Fumé appellation. This calcareous limestone, present only to the east of the vineyard, provides the vines with an ideal water supply, also during hot and dry vintages. This particular soil offers a wine with a chiseled & lively profile, initially dominated by citrus notes, which then expand on the palate and offer more structure. Selected from the lower slopes of Favray, the Tonnerre cuvée requires longer aging to express its full potential. This wine is an excellent choice to pair with seafood and fish dishes. **BOTTLE 65**

Domaine Louis Moreau, Chablis 1er Cru Vau Ligneau, Burgundy, France | 2021

Chablis Premier Cru Vau Ligneau by Louis Moreau comes from the French wine-growing region north of Burgundy which is famous all over the world for being able to give the unique expressions of Chardonnay: the Chablis. This grape variety is composed of this white wine from calcareous soils, very mineral. Harvesting takes place manually and is followed by alcoholic fermentation by native yeasts. Ageing occurs in steel containers for about 18 months. Golden yellow for the eye, it reveals a perfume of fruits such as pineapple and lemon, refreshed by a mineral trace and a light menthol memory. In the mouth, the flavour is very fine and well integrated into the body. Pure balance, this elegant Chablis stays in the mouth with a nice aromatic entanglement. This white is ideal to accompany crustaceans and fish crudités. Perfect to accompany even our lobster with butter sauce. **BOTTLE 85**

Puligny-Montrachet, Remoissenet Pere & Fils, Burgundy, France | 2020

Brilliant gold color with a green reflection. Rich and complex nose with aromas of hawthorn, ripe grape variety, almond paste, hazelnut, citrus fruit and green apple, a touch of warm croissant and vanilla, supported by the necessary minerality. The name Remoissenet for serious collectors stands for refined, classic Burgundy wines. This 150-year old estate is now more than ever the definitive source for the finest wines Burgundy has to offer. **BOTTLE 125**

Rosé - Vin Rosé

Coteaux du Castellans, Cabel Gris, Languedoc, France | 2022

Grenache and Cinsault are the grape varieties used for this rosé. Subtle aromas of red fruit, spices, lime and grapefruit. A great example of an elegant, light-footed Gris: a very pale rosé thanks to minimal skin contact. Delicious rosé paired with grilled dishes. **GLASS 6 | BOTTLE 30**

Classique Rosé, Chateau d'Ollières, Provence, France | 2022

This wine is made from a blend of different grape varieties, including Grenache, Cinsault and Syrah. These grapes are carefully harvested by hand and then pressed in a delicate way to obtain the best juice. The wine has a light salmon pink color, typical of Provencal Rosé. On the nose it offers aromas of red fruit, such as strawberries and raspberries, accompanied by floral notes and a hint of spiciness. On the palate, this Rosé is fresh and lively, with a good balance between fruity and refreshing acidity. It has a smooth texture and an elegant finish. Pairs amazingly with fish and shellfish dishes! **GLASS 9 | BOTTLE 45**



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Red - Red - Vins Rouges

Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot, De Grendel, West-Cape, South-Africa | 2021

Bright ruby colour with a light red border. Fruity with distinct features of raspberries, blackberries and plums. Medium-bodied with a rich and persistent mouthfeel. **GLASS 6 | BOTTLE 30**

Tempranillo Casa Lluch, Bodegas Enguera, Valencia, Spain | 2022

This wine has a bright ruby red colour. It has aromas of plums, berries and black cherries. As if this were not already impressive, cinnamon, gingerbread spice and oriental spices are added by ageing in stainless steel. It's an ideal wine for drinkers who like dry wines. But it's not barren or brittle, but round and supple. It has a silky texture a velvety mouthfeel, without missing out on juicy liveliness, with a nice lingering after taste. **GLASS 7 | BOTTLE 35**

Pinot Noir (Spätburgunder), Gerd Stepp, Pfalz, Germany | 2021

Stepp Pinot Noir is a fruity and smooth red wine, elegant and with light earthy notes. We taste fruit of strawberries, cherries and blackberries, but in the distance also cinnamon and bay leaf. The wine has a mild acidity and little tannin, so flexibility is guaranteed. **GLASS 7 | BOTTLE 35**

Selengaia Chianti, Az. Agr. Il Giardino di Segio Falzari, Tuscany, Italy | 2020

This wine is made from Sangiovese with an addition of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. This wine is intense red and has aromas of ripe red fruit and spices. The biodynamic Chianti clay soil comes from the Colli (hills) Montalbano, west of Florence. The winery is in the village of Vinci. No wood is used in the vinification process, so that the fruit and herbs are beautifully reflected in the wine. The vines are at least 20 years old and located on the south and southeast. This winery has a special place in our heart as we visited the winery in the summer of 2023 and fell in love with the philosophy and the passion they have of wine and wine-making. **GLASS 8 | BOTTLE 40**

Pilandra Toscana Rosso, Az. Agr. Il Giardino di Sergio Falzari, Tuscany, Italy | 2018

Made out of 100% Sangiovese, with intense and elegant aromas of red flowers in harmony with a wide range of spices, it's harmonious on the palate with fine tannins and long aftertaste. The wine is 90% matured in concrete barrels, the rest is aged in French oak barriques, to limit the aromatic imprint of wood on the wine. After that, the wine matures in the bottle for at least 6 months. Recommended with red, roasted and braised meat. This winery has a special place in our heart as we visited the winery in the summer of 2023 and fell in love with the philosophy and the passion they have of wine and wine-making. **BOTTLE 55**

Bodega Gómez Cruzando, Rioja Reserva, Spain | 2010

This wine is made 100% of Tempranillo, from vineyards with 'bushvines' against the foothills of the Cantabrian mountains. 18 months aged in half American and half French oak, both new and used. Then matured further in the cellars of the bodega for 2 years in the bottle. Layered wine, with soft flavours of ripe black fruit (cherry, plum, blackberry), notes of spices (including vanilla), something of cedar wood, tutti frutti. Rich and long aftertaste. Mature wine with a gentle character. **BOTTLE 60**

Domini Veneti, Valpolicella Ripasso Classico Superiore DOC 'La Casetta', Veneto, Italy | 2019

Ripasso stands for the way in which this wine is made. The used must of the Amarone is poured over (passed again; Ripasso) with the juice of the just harvested Valpolicella grapes. A second fermentation takes place that produces a small Amarone, as it were. At Domini Veneti they are famous for their Ripasso from the village of La Casetta. Harvesting takes place in late September and early October. Deep red ruby colour with hints of violet, Intense aroma of cherries, spices and chocolate. On the palate a nice round full flavour, think of dried dark fruits. Juicy and rich. The aftertaste is elegant and long. **BOTTLE 65**



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Red - Red - Vins Rouges

Gérard Bertrand, Château de Villamajou Grand Vin, Languedoc-Roussillon, France | 2021

Château de Villamajou Grand Vin is the result of an encounter between the exceptional Boutenac terroir, original grape varieties and the winemaker's expertise. The remarkable quality of this cuvée lies in the exceptional quality of the grapes. The estate's vines are 80 years old for the Carignan and 30 years old for the Syrah. The grapes are harvested by hand and aged in barrels for 10 to 12 months. Château de Villamajou reveals notes of toast, licorice and clove. It offers powerful, elegant aromas of jammy fruit, sweet spices and roasting. The wine is round on the palate, with mellow tannins and a long, aromatic finish. **BOTTLE 70**

Domaine Usseglio, Châteauneuf-Du-Pape, Côtes du Rhône, France | 2021

This Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge with strong Grenache dominance is a reflection of the mix of the different grape varieties and different soils of our appellation. Structured wine with fine and elegant tannins, a carafe is necessary for the first years. Unfiltered wine, excuse a possible natural deposition and promotes the ageing of the wine. Grapes 80% grenache, 20% mourvèdre, syrah, cinsault and counoise. The king of the South Rhone. Beautiful Châteauneuf-du-Pape of family business with Italian roots. Fleshy wine with a rich flavour of ripe fruit and minerality. Great with beef. **BOTTLE 77**

Grimaldi Barolo DOCG, Giacomo, Piemonte, Italy | 2019

Barolo is the king of wines because it needs the most precious source of everything: time. Ferruccio Grimaldi continues the work of his father. This Barolo is a classic, traditional Barolo made from nebbiolo grapes grown in specific vineyards: Terlo in Barolo, Sotto Castello di Novello in Novello. Beautiful aromas of red fruits, roses and tea. After two years of barrel and bottle ageing, the wine has a scent of truffles and leather, an extremely complex bouquet. In the mouth beautiful acids and soft tannin despite his youth. **GLASS 17 | BOTTLE 85**

Allegrini Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico DOCG, Veneto, Italy | 2018

The result of the Allegrini family's expertise, a true classic of the appellation, this red wine embraces tradition, territory and the know-how of country ways. Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella and Oseleta are left to air dry at least until December and are checked daily to ensure perfectly healthy grapes. Lengthy refining and ageing finally yields a red wine that has become emblematic of Italian oenology. It has imposing structure and depth, as much in its aromas of mature fruit and spices, as on the palate, where the alcohol is sustained by the right degree of acidity and refined tannins. **BOTTLE 125**

Zeet - Sweet - Vins Doux

Bernkasteler Kabinett Riesling, Schmitt-Sohne, Mosel, Germany | 2021

Full and concentrated in taste, with a fresh aftertaste. Spätlese literally means 'late harvest'. This is why the wine is sweeter due to a higher concentration of sugars. Intense in taste and concentrated. **GLASS 6 | BOTTLE 30**

St. André Côtes de Gascogne, Domaine de Joÿ, Gascogne, France

This cuvée is a sweet (dessert) wine with a golden yellow colour. Nose is explosive with plenty of exotic fruit (pineapple, mango, lychee). Balanced with enough refreshing acids to counterweight the sweetness. **GLASS 7.5 | BOTTLE 37.5**

Bacca d'oro Passito, Fondo Antico, Sicily, Italy

Gold-coloured dessert wine made from late harvested grapes. In the nose penetrating scents such as orange blossom and fresh citrus fruits. The wine is sweet and has the body you can expect, without being sticky. Excellent sweet and sour balance. **GLASS 9 | BOTTLE 45**



Sake Selection

SHO CHIKU BAI "Tokubetsu Junmai" Glass hot or cold): GLASS 7.5 | BOTTLE €52.50 * (2)

Alcohol: 15,5% Dryness: +3 Rice polishing: 60% Hyogo prefecture

This premium Junmai sake presents with aromas of warmed buckwheat, spice, damp wood and hot, briny water. Flavors of dried mushroom, spice and dashi prevail. As the sake cools, the flavor focus evolves toward a suggestion of wheat toast, accented by melon, and salted Asian pear.

SHIRAKABEGURA "Kimoto Junmai" GLASS 9.5 | BOTTLE €68 * (3)

Alcohol 15%, Dryness +2, Rice polishing 70%, Hyogo prefecture

This sake is made with nutrient-rich water called Miyamizu, famous for producing drier sake. They've incorporated the orthodox kimoto brewing method to produce a nuanced softer texture. The aroma is akin to lightly roasted nuts and shiitake mushroom, followed by a rich, creamy flavor and umami resting on the dry finish.

SHIRAKABEGURA "Junmai Daiginjo" BOTTLE €78

Alcohol 15,5%, Dryness 0, Rice polishing 45%, Hyogo prefecture

It has a full-bodied palate with a hint of sweetness and a smooth, velvety feel in the mouth. Clear and bright in the glass, it has subtle aromas of pear, melon, banana and petrichor. The flavors of vanilla, melon, banana and white mushroom are enhanced by a hint of sweetness.

KENKONICHI "Tokubetsu Junmai Karakuchi" GLASS 10.5 | BOTTLE €72 * (1)

Alcohol 15%, Dryness +4, Rice polishing 55%, Miyagi prefecture

The most remarkable character of this sake is that it is a rice "Sasanishiki". Sasanishiki is a table rice representative of eastern Japan, born in Miyagi prefecture. It is a smooth texture and has a very gentle and delicate taste with gentle umami flavours. Crisp finish

ZAO "Junmai Ginjo K" GLASS 12.5 | BOTTLE 80 * (4)

Alcohol 16%, Dryness +1, Rice polishing 60%, Miyagi prefecture

Floral with strawberry and blueberry aromas. Zingy, lively and concentrated on the palate. Won the bronze award in the Junmai Ginjo category in the International Wine Challenge 2021.

MIYAKANBAI "Junmai Daiginjo" BOTTLE 88

Alcohol: 15%, Dryness -1, Rice polishing 45%, Miyagi prefecture

The signature sake of Miyakanbai bringing rich fruity aromas of mango, pineapple and pear with clean fleshy rice notes. A well-rounded sake which is rich and juicy, yet with a silky and gentle texture. An elegant sake to sip and enjoy.
