'Nigori' means cloudy in Japanese. It retains a small amount of rice lees by using coarse filtering in the final stage. This premium ginjo nigori has a silky smooth texture and refined flavour.

KOUEIGIKU JUNMAI GINJO 100ML 10 / 720ML 69

Characterised by bright fruit aromatics, gentle umami and vibrant acidity, Sukai reflects the brewery's modern yet traditional approach to sake brewing, offering a beautifully balanced profile that's both approachable and nuanced.

PREMIUM SAKE GRADES (TOKUTEI MEISHOUSU)

These are classified based on the percentage of rice milled away and whether brewer's alcohol is added.

- **Junmai Daiginjo** ($\leq 50\%$): The highest grade, polished to 50% or less. It is fragrant, delicate, and complex.
- **Daiginjo** ($\leq 50\%$): Same high polishing as Junmai Daiginjo but with a small amount of brewers' alcohol added to create a lighter, more aromatic, and cleaner taste.
- **Junmai Ginjo** ($\leq 60\%$): Made with rice polished to 60% or less. It offers a fruity aroma and a smooth taste.
- **Ginjo** ($\leq 60\%$): Polished to 60% or less with added alcohol. It is known for an elegant aroma and light body.
- **Junmai** ($\leq 70\%$): "Pure Rice" sake, containing only rice, water, and koji. It tends to be more acidic with a richer, "ricey" flavor.
- **Kijo-shu** ($\leq 70\%$): Kijoshu is a specialized, premium dessert-style sake produced by replacing some or all of the water with previously brewed sake during the final fermentation stage. While not a "grade" in terms of rice polishing ratio (like Daiginjo), it is treated as a premium, often luxurious product, usually with high acidity and deep sweetness.



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
